INTRODUCTION

This document details all Perpetual Trophies and other Awards presented by the UK 29er Class Association at the various events it is responsible for as organiser alongside host clubs, and sponsors.

It details the trophies that are awarded at each event, and the criteria which govern how each award is made to a designated winner.

Perpetual Trophies

These trophies are awarded to designated winners at specific events.

They are to be held by the winners for a period of up to one year, at which point they should be returned to the UK 29er Class Association, such that they can be awarded appropriately at the corresponding event in the subsequent year.

Winners of all such trophies are responsible for:

- Ensuing that a Trophy is engraved (at each winners expense). Normal engraving requirements are:
 - “Year , Helm Name, Crew Name” , using the same engraving font as has been used for all previous engravings;
 - Where a trophy has a different engraving format for a Winners details, then this format should be followed.
- The safety of a Trophy for the period of time that it is in their possession;
- The safe return of a trophy to the UK 29er Class Association in time for it to be awarded at the next corresponding event in the subsequent year.

Keepsake Trophies

These ‘Keepsake’ Trophies are awarded to designated winners at specific events, and are permanent momento’s of achievement at that event.

All such trophies do not need to be returned.

Such Awards are normally defined in the Notice of Race for each event.
