## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the 29er and 49er classes.

2.2 Entries may be made at the race office at Hayling Island SC.

2.3 **Parent/Guardian Declarations:** All helms and crews under 18 years of age during the event shall submit signed Parent/Guardian Declarations either by post or at registration.

### 3 FEES

Entry fee per boat: £28.00.

### 4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Registration:

Saturday 4 July from 09:00 hrs.

4.2 Dates of racing:

4 & 5 July 2009.

4.3 Number of races:

8 races (4 per day)

4.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on 4 July is 12:55, and on 5 July is 10:55.

### 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

### 6 PENALTY SYSTEM

6.1 The exoneration penalty and the advisory hearing and RYA arbitration of the RYA Rules Disputes Procedures will be available.

6.2 For both classes rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

### 7 SCORING

7.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

7.2 (a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When four or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

### 8 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded based on entry numbers.

### 10 RIGHTS TO USE NAMES & LIKENESSES

Competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.

### 11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility. It is for competitors to decide

whether their boat and its helm and crew are fit to sail in the conditions that they might find. By launching or going to afloat competitors confirm their boat is fit for those conditions and that they are competent to sail and compete in them. Nothing done by the organizers can reduce the responsibility of the owners and/or competitors, nor will it make the organizers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organizers encompass everyone helping to run the event and include the organizing authority, race committee, race officer, safety officer, patrol boat personnel and beach masters. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve owners and competitors of their responsibilities.

**12 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2million per event or the equivalent.

**13 LOCAL RULES**

Dogs are not allowed on the site.

Draycote Water Sailing Club reserves the right to make a condition of entry that a visiting boat be properly disinfected
