I will be on site at the venue during training or make arrangements for an adult person acting in loco parentis to be present and made known to the Head coach. If the event is more than one day, I, or the notified person acting in loco parentis, will take responsibility for my dependant Participant from the end of the last coaching session each day until the commencement of training on the following day.

## INFORMATION

### Applications for All Training:

1. Eligibility: All Participants must be UK 29er Class Association members at the time of application and at the time of the training event. There is no age or ability restriction.
2. Applications and payment must be received at latest **21 days** prior to the training event(s) being booked. Late entries will only be accepted if places are available.
3. Entry is granted on a ‘first come first served’ basis and there will be a maximum number of places available at each event. Entries may be refused.
4. Entries will be acknowledged by e-mail, please ensure email addresses are legible and correct.
5. You are advised not to travel without ensuring you have a confirmed place, as the Organisers reserve the right not to accept registration on the day if they do not have enough coaches to run the event.
6. Fees are not refundable unless, 21 days notice of cancellation is given, or if training is cancelled in advance by the Organisers, or your place can be taken by another boat.
7. Payment must be made by cheque, payable to ‘**UK 29er Class Association**’ and accompany the application form.

1. All boats should be rigged and prepared for the published start time.
2. Participants should not be changed until advised by coach.
3. All Participants will be expected to be properly equipped with adequate clothing/wetsuits and personal buoyancy. Please note most clubs require sailors to wear wetsuits/dry suits during winter months.  
**The Organisers/coaches reserve the right to exclude any Participants insufficiently prepared for the conditions.**
4. Bring a notebook and pen.

### Food & Accommodation:

All Participants are expected to make their own arrangements for food and accommodation during the training event. The Organisers generally expect the club galley to be open at these events but this cannot be guaranteed.
